IREVA Facilities with Mandated Requirements for Sanctioning

This document is to track those facilities which need special attention above & beyond the normal requirements for hosting an IREVA event. **Tournaments at these facilities will be approved/sanctioned only if the requirements listed below are followed.**

Additional Important Information:

Tournament Directors must confirm, BEFORE the event is requested for sanctioning and again before the event is held, that all equipment and other such expected needs are indicated in/going to be met via the facility contact (i.e. court lines, nets, standards, antenna, ref stands, visible scoreboards, tables, chairs, lighting, heat, staff to open/close, etc.) or that they will be met through other resources with detailed explanations of how and by whom in the contract. Tournament Director's need to check on these items so that they are getting what they pay for and what they expect to receive in running a quality tournament before sanctioning it as such and to avoid unnecessary last minute scurrying for court equipment, official court lines, padding unsafe objects, building unofficial ref stands, etc.

During the event, the Head Referee will validate that all facilities are adequate. If an event takes place that does not provide the sanction requirements below, satisfactory equipment, and safety requirements, the Tournament Director's performance bond will be forfeited and could prevent the team &/or club from hosting future events. All questions/concerns regarding facilities should be sent to the Tournament/Insurance Coordinator (tournament@ireva.org). If a site visit is needed to validate that a site's safety now meets the requirements listed below, one will be arranged.

ABC Sports & Fitness	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Court's center line must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Excess court divider net must be taped or tied off the floor. *Score Table & Chairs must be provided
Albany Academy for Girls - Big Gym	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Bleachers may not be pulled out if two courts are being used.
Albany Academy for Girls - Small Gym	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website.
Berne Knox Westerlo H.S.	*All lines must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Teams/Players/Parents cannot have their personal belongings around the courts. All chairs, gym bags, etc must be on the bleachers or in the hallway.
Broome County Community College - West Gym	Back wall must have exposed wooden splinters removed or covered to avoid injury.
Canajoharie H.S.	* Court's center line must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website.
Pine Bush H.S.	*All court lines must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website.
Queensbury Middle School	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website.
Russell Sage College - NEFF Athletic Center - Main Gym (Wood Floor)	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Teams/Players/Parents cannot have their personal belongings around the courts. All chairs, gym bags, etc must be on the bleachers or in the hallway.
South Glens Falls H.S.	*Service lines must be taped with a contrasting color to allow for a full two-meter Service Area. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website.
SUNY Cortland - Lusk Field House	*All courts must have safe ref stands including padding.

University at Albany	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Service lines & center lines on courts with tan painted court lines must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *All courts must have safe ref stands including padding. *Net poles must have proper padding *All Nets must have antennas
World Volleyball Training Center	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Adult Tournaments will not be approved. * Only 4 courts with acceptable spacing can be used to hold a sanctioned event. *Service lines to allow for a full two-meter Service Area & center lines on courts must be taped with a contrasting color. See "USAV Floor Tape Guidelines" on the Forms & Documents page of the IREVA website. *Limit area around courts where Teams/Players/Parents can spectate and/or leave their personal belongings.
